Dear Boonville Water Utility Customers:

At its September 1, 2016 meeting, the Common Council of the City of Boonville, Indiana (the "Council" and the "City", respectively) introduced Ordinance 2016-11, which if approved would remove the City's municipal water utility from the jurisdiction of the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (the "IURC") for the approval of rates, charges, issuance of bonds, and related matters (the "Ordinance"). The majority of cities and towns within the State of Indiana that own and operate water utilities have already taken action to withdraw from the IURC's jurisdiction, as the City is now considering.

The process for removing the City's water utility from the IURC's jurisdiction is set forth in Indiana Code § 8-1.5-3-9.1. The Council plans to consider the Ordinance at its October 6, 2016 meeting, where it will hear comments on the proposed Ordinance from any ratepayers of the City's water utility or the interested public. This letter is to provide notice of that public meeting.

The specific time, date, and location of the meeting are as follows:


Date/Time: October 6, 2016, 5:00 p.m. CST.

The City invites your participation at the October 6, 2016 public meeting. During the meeting, the City will also provide an explanation of the removal process. At that meeting or a subsequent meeting, the Council may consider adoption of Ordinance.
