Robert Canada said that he wasn't originally in favor of the tax abatement for Shigley Holdings; however, he is pleased with their accomplishments and improvements to the property.





Councilman David Talley asked Shawn about getting prices on Maple Grove.


Councilman Bob Canada asked about 2 dead trees at City Lake and the algae control is bad.


